Lent Course 2026 – The Bible Course

As the course runs over eight sessions, we will need to start a little bit before Lent. The plan is to run the course over eight successive Thursday evenings, from 7-8.30 pm, starting on Thursday 5th February and finishing on Thursday 26th March.

This is a professionally-produced course with videos and other attractive teaching material. As there is already a Friends of St Peter's Fundraiser booked for Thursday 19th March, we will need either to meet earlier or on the Wednesday of that week. Perhaps we might meet a little earlier and have something to eat.
