Friday 21st August, 7pm for 7.30pm start or 'Eyes Down'!

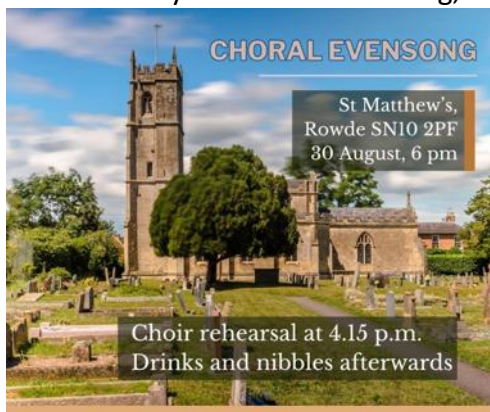
